

Outstanding Ofsted Report achieved by Fosse Bank School

On Wednesday 19th November 2008 a team of Ofsted inspectors visited Fosse Bank School for a 'Light Touch' inspection which applies to schools who achieved good results in their previous inspection.

The inspectors judged the school to have Outstanding provision when safeguarding pupils' welfare, health and safety, and in the provision for the spiritual, moral, social and cultural development of the pupils. They judged other areas to be Good with some Outstanding features.

The inspectors wrote that, "children and their families are overwhelmingly positive about the school" and with regard to the pupils' behaviour they commented that, "there are high expectations of pupils to conduct themselves appropriately... Their outstanding behaviour and consideration for others contributes significantly to the smooth running of the school and the safety and well-being of themselves and others. Among their many other qualities, pupils are confident, respectful, polite, and demonstrate an understanding of the needs and differences of others."
